PGL End of Year Rewards Trip

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to PGL Osmington Bay from Friday 11th July 2025 to Monday 14th July 2025. Your child has been invited on this trip due to demonstrating consistently fantastic behaviour throughout the year in line with the school's PROUD values.

Students will leave the school at 12pm on Friday 11th July 2025 and travel by coach to and from Osmington Bay returning to school at 3pm, on Monday 14th July 2025. Students will be required to have enough clothing for four days. The cost of the trip includes 3 nights' accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner, coach travel, and all activities. Students are able to bring additional money to purchase items at the on-site shop.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available, and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The total cost of this trip is £340. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable deposit of £140, by Friday 21^{st} March 2025.

Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip and all subsequent payments (also non-refundable) must be made by the dates set out below:

- Second instalment of £100 by 18th April 2025
- Balance of £100 by 23rd May 2025

Please note that once the trip is completed all costs will be analysed and if applicable a refund will be made.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use Arbor to pay for this trip. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to <u>finance@uhs.org.uk</u>.

- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
