## Visit to GCSE Geography Field Studies - Year 11

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Amersham on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2025. This visit will run over two days, with some students attending on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> and others attending on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> February. The aim of this visit is to for geography students in Year 10 to consolidate their learning on the geographical application component of the geography GCSE.

Students will leave the school at 8.45am on either Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February or Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> February and travel by coach to and from Amersham, returning to school at 4pm. Students will be allowed to wear their own cloths for this trip, however, please note that these may get wet and it is advisable for students to bring a spare set of clothes to change in to. If students have waterproof clothing and footwear, please encourage them to bring these. Students will require a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

The cost of this trip is £47.50. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £47.50, before Monday,  $10^{\text{th}}$  February 2025. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip.
