Year 7 Parents' Evening

We are pleased to invite you to the Year 7 parents' evening on Thursday 6th February, which will be held in our Lancaster building. During this event, you will have the opportunity to discuss your child's progress with subject staff and their form tutor. We will be using our online booking system for parents to book their own teacher appointments. To start booking, you will need to create an account on the following website: https://uhsbooking.parentseveningsystem.co.uk.

Appointment slots will go live at 8.30am on Wednesday 29th January and close at 4pm on Tuesday 4th February.

We have included a 'how to guide' with this letter, which explains exactly how the system works and how you can make appointments. If you experience any difficulties, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

Since it is vital that problems relating to subjects or homework are fully resolved as soon as possible, please bring your child with you, so that they can benefit from the evening's discussions.
